Delta, Colorado, June 1, 2020 – Delta County Daily Update

UPDATED Testing Information: Delta County Health Department is reporting one new case; our total case count is now 69 with 64 individuals now recovered.

- #69 - Male, in his 40s, self-isolating at home

40 individuals have tested positive; 29 individuals have been in close contact with an individual who tested positive, and have experienced COVID-19 symptoms, and one death is being reported.

State Update:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) today released additional modeling results. The state added guidance for short-term rentals today, and it goes into effect immediately. In addition, the state revised the guidelines for personal services and child care, which will go into effect June 4.

With the knowledge of the latest modeling data, the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment is also seeking feedback on draft guidelines today. Coloradans can review draft guidelines in the following areas:
